Board of Library Trustees Minutes 7/20/21

Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM.

Public Comments: None.

Additions to the Agenda: Update on Patron Blocks, Women's Club, and library Café.

Approval of Minutes: June 15, 2021 minutes approved.

Reports:

Director: Judy reported that in June over 1,500 items were checked out and over 2,300 eBooks/eAudiobooks were borrowed from Libby/OverDrive. There were 6,900 measurable uses of NPL e-collections and a total of 132 new library cards were issued. NPL offered a variety of programs in June which consisted of virtual, outdoor, and indoor programs. Due to Diane Rodriguez's upcoming retirement, the Adult Services Librarian position will be posted shortly. NPL welcomed back Emily Goodwin as the new Young Adult/Technology Librarian. Her first day is Tuesday, July 20th.

Financial: As of the end of June, the remaining balance in personnel services is -\$6,097.08. The remaining balance in general expenses is \$6,760.48. The total for the cash drawer receipts from July-June is \$1,207.62, and the total for copier money is \$0.

Friends/Foundation: The Friends Room is open and they are now accepting donations. The Friends are looking to recruit new members and have information outside of the Friends Room for interested volunteers.

The Foundation generously donated \$10,203.98 to the Library Building Project to cover the cost of the outdoor benches and bike racks in the Library's courtyard.

Building Project Update: Work continues on addressing punch list items, including the HVAC system, site drainage, outdoor book drop, and other issues. The Library Building Committee continues to meet bi-weekly and construction meetings will continue to occur weekly. The LBC's next meeting is Thursday, July 29th.

Board Reorganization: Monika Brodsky was re-elected as Chair and Jeanne Hagelstein-Ivas was elected as Vice Chair.
